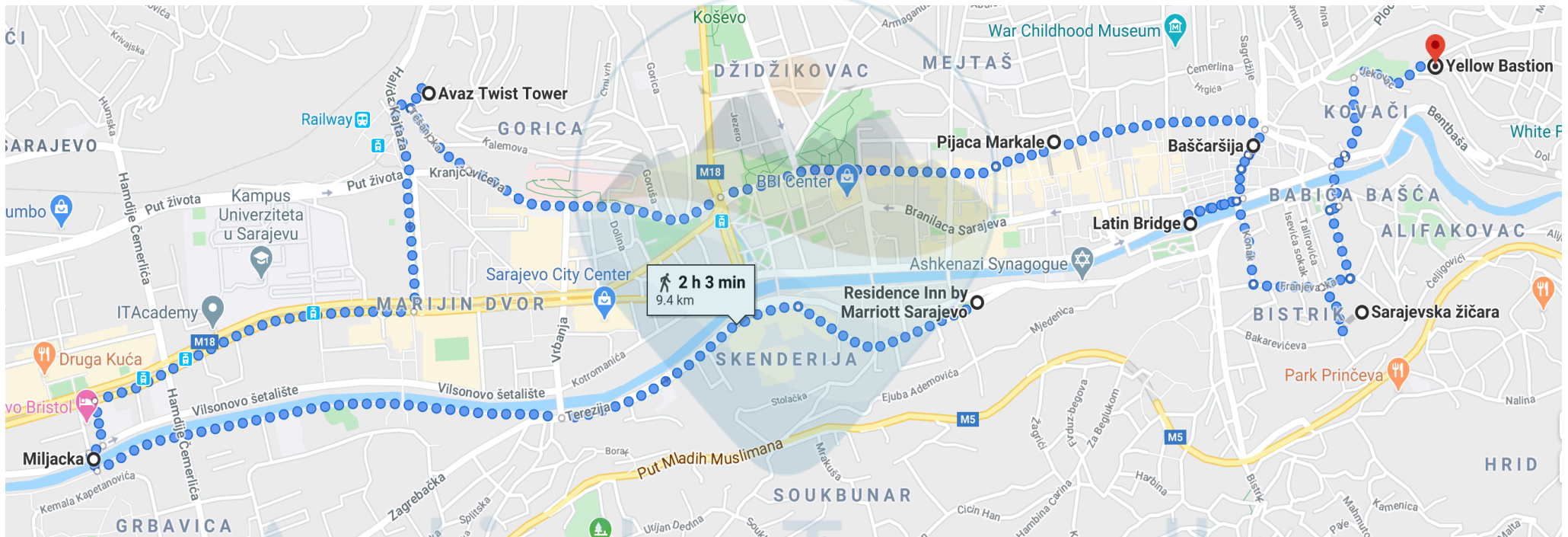

Travelling	<p><b>By Air:</b> Sarajevo Airport (SJJ) is the nearest airport to Sarajevo (9.3 km).</p> <p><b>By Taxi:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Airport to Sarajevo City Center (\$16)</li> <li>○ Airport to Sarajevo Stari Grad (\$21)</li> <li>○ Airport to Mostar</li> </ul> <p><b>By Car:</b> Hiring a car is available from the airport or locally *Pre-book in advance to get a better price, petrol is cheap.</p> <p><b>By Bus:</b> Sarajevo Airport (Extremely Cheap &amp; Easy to Do)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Airport to Tivat (taxi) bus to Kotor Old Town (\$3)</li> <li>○ Airport to Tivat (taxi) bus to Kotor Port (\$6)</li> <li>○ Airport to Mostar (\$100) – Train \$28</li> </ul>	<p>24 minutes</p> <p>28 minutes</p> <p>2 hours</p>	<p>Hotel 1 - A walk along <b>Miljacka river East</b> is a historic walk and visit where WW1 started and walk back through the Old Town.</p> <p>Walk towards activities, stop off at <b>Avaz Twist Tower</b> (highest building in the Balkans with full Sarajevo views).</p> <p>Head through <b>Plijaca Markale</b> as the main marketplace.</p> <p><u>Lunch</u> <b>Bascarsija Square</b> for best Burek in the Balkans (Burekdžinica Bosna).</p>	<p><b>Latin Bridge</b> is historic in its own right, with Franz Ferdinand and his wife being shot on it, this prompted WW1.</p> <p><b>Sarajevska žičara</b> is the cable car that takes you up the mountain, there are many places to see the history from above Sarajevo.</p> <p><b>Yellow Bastion</b> (Fortress) has panoramic views of the city (Sunset spot).</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ <b>Zlatna Ribica</b> is an interesting bar to visit with a vintage style.</li> <li>○ Head back to <b>Bascarsija Square</b> for some of the Bosnian nightlife.</li> <li>○ <b>Bokun</b> has the very best local wine with live music.</li> </ul> <p><u>Best Restaurants</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Dinner at <b>Toplik</b>- local produce.</li> <li>○ Best meat free &amp; smoke free restaurant - <b>Karuzo</b>.</li> <li>○ <b>Zara iz Duvara</b> is the local go-to restaurant.</li> </ul> <p>*Book all restaurants to avoid disappointment</p>
